Please state the ground(s) for review (please read guidance note 1)
The premises have been the subject of 2 failed test purchase operations in a 9 month period namely November 2008 and July 2009.

A test purchase operation was undertaken by officers from the Licensing Department, Northern Division on Saturday 15<sup>TH</sup> November 2008, where 2 15 year old females attempted to purchase alcohol being under age and without any recognisable means of identification. The sale was made and the young persons were sold 2 bottles of blue WKD.

The sale was made by a Chantelle Leeming who was ultimately issued with a penalty notice for disorder by PC 2643 Cheetham.

On Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2008 a licensing surgery was conducted at the premises with the manager, Elleray Taylor and Andrew McClatchie the Designated Premises Supervisor together with PC Bernhardt from the Licensing Department. The purpose of the surgery was ascertain what measures were in place pertaining to staff training and underage sales.

It was evident that any training was unstructured and non verifiable due to the complete lack of any documentation. The refusals/challenge book was inadequate, there was no till prompt in place and no refresher training existed whatsoever.

It was recommended that an induction training package, refresher training package should be implemented forthwith together with an adequate refusals/challenge book and a till prompt for alcohol sales. It was advised that all training records should be held on the premises for at least 12 months and to be produced to the police or other statutory authority.

On Friday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2009 officers from the Licensing Department, Northern Division conducted a second test purchase operation at the same premises together with officers from the Trading Standards Department where two 16 year old young persons, male and female, attempted to purchase alcohol being under age and without any recognisable means of identification. The sale was made and the male young person bought a pint of Foster Lager and a glass of white wine.

The sale was made by a Michael Jenkinson who was ultimately issued with a penalty notice for disorder by PC Bernhardt.

A subsequent surgery was held at the premises with Elleray Taylor and Andrew McClatchie together with PC Bernhardt, the purpose of which was to establish what training methods were in place regarding under age sales and indeed to assess the recommendations of the previous surgery.

The officer noted that all previous recommendations had been fully implemented, the existing Age Check DVD was still being utilised for both initial and refresher training however documented knowledge tests and dated endorsements for all members of staff were in evidence. Other documentation in the form of in house exercises were also available.

The premises now adopted a 'challenge 25' policy, the challenge/refusals book was in order and utilised regularly and a new till system with a prompt for alcohol sales was now in place. Underage signage was also evident.
