Dear Pablo,

Thank you for agreeing to meet me today to discuss your application and measures you intend to implement to prevent any nuisance arising from the proposed activities.

I have considered the information that you have provided in terms of the type of venue you intend to operate and the information that you have obtained following the sound testing (which if you could forward our records please).

As agreed, and in conjunction with discussions with the council's Licensing Team, it would be acceptable to use a noise limiting device, to prevent music noise levels being audible from within nearest noise sensitive receptors. This can be included as a condition on your Premises Licence and would be subject to Environmental Health validation prior to the premises becoming operational.

Please confirm whether this is agreeable and then I will confirm this with the Licensing Team as part of my consultation response.
