<p>To delegate the Chief Executive to finalise and agree an award of UK Shared Prosperity Fund (UKSPF) funds in respect of the following Interventions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- E11: Capacity building &amp; infrastructure support for local groups</li> <li>- E13: Community measures to reduce the cost of living</li> </ul> <p>Funds will be awarded as set out in the council's UKSPF Investment Plan and within the parameters of the UKSPF change control process, to deliver the following projects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Cost of Living Community Support</li> <li>- Feasibility Study: Net Zero Community Hub</li> <li>- Community Learning Network</li> </ul>			
<b>Reasons for the decision:</b>			
<p>Lancaster City Council's UKSPF Investment Plan sets out its plan for delivering the Lancaster district's £5.3m UKSPF allocation from 2022-25. The Investment Plan was agreed by government in December 2022.</p> <p>Implementing the UKSPF programme requires the council to allocate funds to a range of projects which will deliver on the outcomes and outputs set out in the Investment Plan. This initial allocation in respect of Interventions E11 and E13 will enable the project(s) to commence delivery at an early stage in the programme and begin creating positive local impact.</p>
