The Group found that the existing scheme struck the appropriate balance between ensuring timely planning application decision-making (in accordance with national timescales), and the necessary consideration of strategic major planning applications at Committee level. A reduction of the number of items at Committee, as suggested by the Peer Review, was therefore not considered appropriate. Member training for Planning Regulatory Committee has been provided since the local elections. The forward training programme has also been agreed and will provide more subject-specific training during the next 12 months.
