<p>To delegate the Chief Executive to finalise and agree an award of Rural England Prosperity Fund (REPF) funds in respect of Intervention SRC6 as set out in the council's REPF addendum and within the parameters of the UKSPF change control process, to deliver the project Canal Access Improvements.</p>			
Reasons for the decision:			
<p>The Lancaster district has been allocated £500,075 by the Department for Food, Environment and Rural Affairs (DEFRA) through the Rural England Prosperity Fund (REPF). The REPF complements the UK Shared Prosperity Fund (UKSPF) in rural areas from April 2023-March 2025.</p> <p>Implementing the REPF requires the council to allocate funds to a range of projects which will deliver on the outcomes and outputs set out in the REPF addendum. This allocation in respect of Intervention SRC6 will enable the projects to commence delivery and begin creating positive local impact.</p>
