The reason for the urgency is to allow the order to be submitted along with the orders of the other districts in the Lancashire Waste Partnership by 6th February 2025 as this will secure a significant discount on the normal purchase price of the products on order.

DECISION TO BE MADE:	In March 2026 the government waste strategy requires local councils to provide a statutory and dedicated food waste collection service. In order to facilitate this service, residents will need to be issued with a 7 litre caddie to store food waste in the house and a larger 23 litre caddie to present food waste at kerbside on collection day. The funding cost for this project is covered by central government burdening fund and has already been paid to Lancaster City Council.
