## **URGENT BUSINESS - TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ACT 2004**

Members are requested to consider a change to be implemented as a result of the Traffic Management Act 2004. Part 6 of the Act relates to parking enforcement and one of the issues to be implemented on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008 is differential penalty charge levels of PCNs issued throughout the District under the Parkwise arrangements. The attached report provides the necessary background information.

Confirmation has just been received from Legal and HR Services that these changes require the existing Off Street Parking Places Order to be revoked and a new one to be prepared and sealed.
