ARTS & EVENTS

Vacant administration post to be deleted

The Dome – future use/availability. Progress report required to next Star Chamber

Note – marketing budgets are to be reviewed as part of a corporate piece of work that includes marketing and promotion

LEISURE

Cultural Services Trust – feasibility options to Cabinet

Organisational change options are to be considered as part of the Review of Service Heads' Post to Personnel Committee

Further report required on other options to meet increased income through fees and charges.

Heysham Mossgate – delay in the project will mean that the £40K included in next year's budget can be taken as a one-off saving

Leisure capital bids are being evaluated by Officers.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & TOURISM

Base budget savings of £8,400 agreed in respect of rationalisation improvements at TIC and Guide Distribution

A further £3K also possible in respect of exhibitions and £1k in respect of Printing and Stationery

Capital bid – Morecambe TIC – with Officers for evaluation
