Public Health Statistics

Members of the Committee met with representatives from Public Health and the CCG to discuss the statistics for the district particularly for self-harm and Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease. At the meeting the Marmot Review was discussed and it was suggested that the public health figures would be considered in the work the Committee was going to undertake later in the year on Marmot.

At the meeting it was suggested that an age breakdown for the self-harm data be obtained as well as adding a comparison with demographically similar areas to the next iteration of the profile.

The Public Health Profile 2014 and the Health and Wellbeing Strategy was circulated to the Committee after the meeting.

It was also suggested that it would be useful for the Committee to have the Action Plan circulated that was being considered by the Health and Well Being Partnership in March.
