**URGENT BUSINESS – THE CITY COUNCIL OF LANCASTER (VARIOUS ROADS) (ON STREET PARKING PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (NO 3) ORDER 2006**

Members are requested to consider eighteen letters received following the advertisement of the proposed Traffic Regulation Order, in accordance with the Council's Urgent Business Procedure, details of which are set out within the attached report.

The urgency for this decision is that due to a clerical error with the previous decision it is necessary to enact the decision prior to the transfer of the Highways function to the County Council and it is impracticable to defer the decision until the next publication date for Individual Cabinet Member Decisions.

From a point 12 metres south of the centre line of Norfolk Street to the highway boundary of Aldren's Lane.      Easterly side.

Aldren's Lane

From the highway boundary of Owen Road to a point 15 metres north of the centre line of Norfolk Street.      Westerly side.

From the highway boundary of Owen Road to a point 11 metres north of the centre line of Norfolk Street.      Easterly side.

ii) Delete the reference to Cork Road and insert the following:

Cork Road

From a point 4 metres south east of the centre line of Ulster Road to a point 2 metres north west of the centre line of Connaught Road.      South westerly side.

(2) Create a new Schedule 3 in which waiting is prohibited between the hours of 8am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday on the following lengths of road:

Cork Road

From a point 2 metres south east of the centre line of Connaught Road to a point 2 metres north west of the centre line of Shrewsbury Drive.      South westerly side.

(3) Create a new Schedule 3 in which waiting is prohibited between the hours of 8am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday on the following lengths of road:

Cork Road

From a point 2 metres south east of the centre line of Connaught Road to a point 2 metres north west of the centre line of Shrewsbury Drive. South westerly side.
