1.1 Councillors Blamire and Rivet were appointed, amongst other Members, to the Single Purpose Standards Committee at Council on 19 December 2018.

2.0 Proposal

2.1 Due to prior commitments Councillor Rivet was unable to attend the Committee meeting on 11 January 2019. After the Council meeting, it was pointed out that, as Leader of the Council, Councillor Blamire should not have been appointed to a Standards Committee (it would contravene paragraph 7,02 of Article 7 in the Council's Constitution). The Labour Group therefore requested that Councillors Hanson and Metcalfe be appointed to the two Labour seats on the Single Purpose Standards Committee, in place of Councillors Rivet and Blamire.

3.0 Consultation

3.1 Since the meeting was to take place on 11 January 2019, the change to membership could not be dealt with at a Council meeting, or by this Committee. The decision was therefore made on 2 January 2019 by the Chief Executive, in consultation with Councillor Reynolds, as per the Council's urgent business procedures.
