1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 Council, on 20 December 2017, resolved to publish its Local Plan and background evidence, obtain formal representations and submit the documents to the government for Independent Examination.
- 1.2 Examination Hearings took place during April and May 2019, including an additional sitting day on Tuesday 21 May 2019. The Inspector is currently deliberating on the soundness of the submitted documents.
- 1.3 On Tuesday 21 May 2019, the council's team advised the Inspector of the change in political administration following the local election of 2 May 2019.
- 1.4 The council's team advised the Inspector that the Leader of the Council and the Portfolio Holder for Economic Regeneration had specifically asked that the Inspector be informed that the council would consider its approach to the ongoing plan preparation process at the first meeting of the newly elected Council on 26 June 2019.
- 1.5 Whilst this matter was not considered on 26 June 2019, this letter has now come to Council for noting.
