- 1542 Footpath enquiry between Whittington and Kirkby Lonsdale, made by parishioner MR and Cllrs, to Lancashire County Council, and including Public Rights of Way historically, have resulted in replies citing "no funding" available for repair of the existing footpath alongside the River Lune or for the provision of a footpath and cycle route sited nearer the B6254. The remaining route, via Biggins, is liable to flooding and this has been reported to Cumbria County Council. Cllrs discussed the possibility of a future community project to renovate the riverside route with appropriate permissions.
