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Details of Decision:

The Chief Executive approves the Lancaster BID's Final Business Improvement District (BID) Renewal Proposals.

Following approval, the Chief Executive will issue instructions for the ballot to proceed.

Reasons for the decision:

The final renewal proposals for Lancaster BID have been completed (final document attached). In Cabinet's approval of a draft version of the proposals at its meeting of 27th October 2020 officers had provided an overview of the draft proposal's compliance with statutory BID Regulations 4 and Schedule 1. No further clarifications were requested.

In issuing this decision the Chief Executive is satisfied the proposals meet the prescribed conditions of a billing authority's approval, namely that the final proposal:

- Covers the issues laid down in BID Regulations 2004 (particularly Regulation 4 and its associated Schedule 1: the required information compliance.)
- The renewal proposals do not conflict with the council's formally published policies.

The ballot administration will be delegated to and undertaken by Lancaster BID and Civica (formerly Electoral Reform Services).

To meet the ballot timetable as indicated in the printed material Civica must be informed of the council's approval of the ballot to proceed on or before 11th November 2020 – this is the latest statutory date from the proposed end of ballot period (11th February 2021) that Civica can issue formal ballot notification.
