Report of Chief Executive

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To consider those Outside Bodies, Partnerships and Boards on which appointments are required.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- (1) That Council confirms the basis on which appointment to outside bodies are made as set out in Appendix A or makes amendments as required.
- (2) That all new appointments made in accordance with the attached schedule be made for a term of office of four years to expire at the City Council Elections to be held in May 2011.

1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 In May 2003 Council agreed new appointments to all outside bodies and partnerships for a four year period following the elections.
- 1.2 In October 2003 it was further agreed that in future Council would merely approve the basis on which all appointment should be made. Where an appointment is made on the basis of PR, the appointing Groups may notify the Head of Democratic Services in writing of their appointment without the need for further Council approval. Cabinet or other Committee representatives are referred to the relevant body for appointment.

2.0 Proposal

- 2.1 Attached at Appendix A is a list of all organisations to which Council has made an appointment and the basis on which these appointments have been made in accordance with previous Council decisions.
- 2.2 Council is requested to reaffirm the basis of these appointments or to put forward any suggested changes.

2.3 Nominations for PR appointments will be requested from Group Administrators for submission in writing to the Head of Democratic Services following the meeting. Appointments to be made by Cabinet or other Committees will be referred directly to the relevant body.

3.0 Options

3.1 Council has the option of making appointments in accordance with proportional representation or by virtue of a councillor's role within the Council, eg. a Member of Cabinet or other Committee or a relevant Ward Councillor.
