ANNEXES

Embedded/Mandatory Conditions

On New Year's Eve alcohol may be sold from the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, 00.00 hours (midnight) on 31st December)

An additional hour to the standard times on the day when British Summertime commences

Credit Sales

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal

NO Children's Certificate

No person under fourteen shall be in the bar of the licensed premises during the permitted hours unless one of the following applies:

- a) He is the child of the holder of the premises licence.
- b) He resides in the premises, but is not employed there.
- c) He is in the bar solely for the purpose of passing to or from some part of the premises that is not a bar and to or from some part of the premises where there is no other convenient means of access or egress.
- d) The bar is in railway refreshment rooms or other premises constructed, fitted and intended to be used bona fide for any purpose to which holding of the licence is ancillary.

In this condition "bar" includes any place exclusively or mainly used for the consumption of intoxicating liquor. However, an area is not a bar when it is usual for it to be, and it is, set apart for the service of table meals and alcohol is only sold or supplied to persons as an ancillary to their table meals.

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises the supply of alcohol

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended
 - (2) The supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence
- 3). (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

- (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children:
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to:
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
 - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on -
 - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring
 - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
- 4. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
- 5. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- 6. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age

verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

- (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
- 7. The responsible person shall ensure that:
 - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures -
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Mandatory condition where Door Supervisors are provided

All individuals who carry out security activities must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority (SIA)

Non standard timings

- On Easter Monday, May, Spring and August Bank Holiday Mondays, Christmas Eve, Boxing Day, 27th
 December and New Year's Day regulated entertainment and the sale/supply of alcohol will be
 permitted until 01.00 hours the following day and the premises may be open to the public until 01.30
 hours the following day
- 2. On New Year's Eve regulated entertainment will be permitted until 01.30 hours the following morning

Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- 1 A personal licence holder shall normally be on the premises at all times during which intoxicating liquor is being sold or supplied to customers or consumed by customers, except in the case of an emergency
- 2. Any person who looks or appears to be under the age of 18 shall be asked to provide identification that they are over the age of 18. The following are the only forms of identification acceptable: UK photo driving licence; Passport; PASS card (proof of age standards scheme).
- 3. The designated premises supervisor or a person nominated by them shall be a member of and regularly attend meetings of any Pubwatch scheme for the area within which the premises are located and would include registration and use of community/network radio.
- 4. Any outside area, which is used for the consumption of alcohol, shall cease to be so used at 23.00 hours.
- 5. The provision of off-sales to terminate at 23.00 hours.

- 6. Before the premises are opened for the purposes authorised by the licence an inspection shall be carried out to ensure that the premises are safe for use. Details of the inspection, defects discovered and remedial action taken shall be recorded in writing in a logbook kept for that purpose. That logbook shall be made available for inspection on demand to an Authorised Officer of the Council, a Fire Officer or a Police Constable.
- 7. At all times when the premises are used for the purpose of the premises licence, the licence holder, manager or designated premises supervisor who is responsible for the management of the premises shall at all times be aware of the number of persons on the premises and shall if requested to do so give that information to an authorised person.
- 8. The front entrance doors which form part of the escape route open against the direction of travel, They shall be locked in the open position by a tamper-proof fastening when ever there are public on the premises.
- 9. The fire alarm, emergency lighting system and electrical installation shall be tested on a regular basis, at a frequency determined by a competent person. Certificates should be issued showing the results of the tests. The certificates shall be made available for inspection on demand to an Authorised Officer of the Council, a Fire Officer or a Police Constable.
- 10. The provision of live music will be limited to three performers at any one time.
- 11 The use of any Karaoke machine will be limited to the ground floor.
- 12. Performances of dance will only take place on the dance floor in the first floor function area.
- 13. Any speaker system used at the premises will have a built in noise limiters.
- 14. The provision of late night refreshment is to be for customers on the premises and there will be no takeaway service.
- 15. There will be no adult entertainment services, activities, other entertainment or matters ancillary to the use of the premises that may give rise to concern in respect of children.
- 16. A Burglar Alarm is linked to a Central Control.
- 17. Fire Alarm-serviced annually.
- 18. Fire extinguishers serviced annually and premises inspected regularly, Additional Fire doors were added at the request of the Fire Authority five years ago.
- 19. There will be no adult entertainment.
- 20. All U16s will be accompanied by adults.

Conditions agreed with Lancashire Constabulary following Minor Variation- October 2012

- (1) To Intall, maintain and use a CCTV system that consists of cameras covering the frontage of the premises, all bar service areas and any other area that customers have access to.
- (2) The CCTV footage must be recording during which all licensable activities are taking place
- (3) CCTV must be kept for at least 21days
- (4) There must be in place a monitor at the venue that can clearly show images captured on the CCTV system and be used for the purposes of reviewing the CCTV images
- (5) There must be a person at the venue at all times, when licensable activity is taking place, that is trained in the use of the CCTV system and can review footage upon lawful police request
- (6) The CCTV hard-drive must be located at the venue

- (7) There must be in place a clear record of all bookings made for private functions held at the venue, which includes that name of the person making the booking and their proof of address
- (8) A written risk assessment must be made prior to all private functions held at the venue and must detail the use of SIA security. All reasonable police requests for security must be complied with and any written risk assessment must be made available to police upon request
