

Appointments to Outside Bodies, Partnerships and Boards 12 May 2025 Report of the Senior Manager, Democratic Support and Elections

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To allow Council to consider its appointments to outside bodies, partnerships and boards, as set out in the report.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- (1) That Council re-confirms appointments to outside bodies as set out in Appendix 1b, or makes appointments and amendments as required.
- (2) That nominations be sought for the vacancy on:

George Fox School Educational Charity

- (3) That the basis of appointment to the Lancashire Police and Crime Panel be reconfirmed and that nominations be sought and an appointment made at this meeting.
- (4) That Council confirms that all appointments made or re-confirmed at this meeting will extend until the next City Council Elections in 2027.

1.0 Introduction

1.1 Following the elections in May 2023, Council agreed new appointments to all outside bodies and partnerships. It is usual for those appointments to remain in place for the four-year term, with a full review due following the next scheduled elections in May 2027, however Council is given the opportunity to review them at each annual meeting.

2.0 Proposal

- 2.1 **Appendix 1a** shows a list of appointments which are made to other bodies by virtue of role or position (such as Ward Councillor or Cabinet Portfolio Holder). Attached at **Appendix 1b** is a list of all organisations where full Council has made the appointment. The names of the Councillors currently appointed are included on the list.
- 2.2 As noted above, appointments made following an election usually cover the four-year term until the next election. The next elections are scheduled for May 2027 and Council

- is asked to approve that all appointments made or re-confirmed at this meeting will extend until the next City Council Elections in 2027.
- 2.3 Should any appointments made on the basis of a Councillor's role be affected by changes to appointments to Cabinet, these will be addressed directly by Cabinet at its first meeting.

3.0 Vacancies

3.1 Following the resignation of Councillor Erin Hall last year, a vacancy has remained open on the **George Fox School Educational Charity**. Council is asked to consider the basis of appointment to this group and, if this is determined as by nomination and voting at Council, that the appointment be made at this meeting.

4.0 Lancashire Police and Crime Panel

- 4.1 The Police and Crime Panel is administered by Blackburn-with-Darwen Council and that Council ensures that, as far as possible, the Panel reflects the political balance of Lancashire each year following local elections.
- 4.2 Lancaster City Council should appoint one Member at this stage. At the 13 May 2024 meeting of Council it was resolved that the basis of appointment to the Lancashire Police and Crime Panel be by nomination and voting at Council.
- 4.3 The City Council might be invited to make a further appointment. Blackburn-with-Darwen will advise in due course if that is the case.

5.0 Combined County Authority (CCA) - Overview and Scrutiny Committee

5.1 Democratic Support has been informed that the Leader of the Council has automatically been appointed to the CCA Overview and Scrutiny Committee by virtue of their position.

6.0 Monitoring of Attendance

- 6.1 At its meeting on 17 December 2014, Council considered a method of monitoring Members' attendance at the outside bodies they have been appointed to. Council resolved:
 - (1) That Councillors appointed to outside bodies inform Democratic Services of the meetings they have attended throughout the year.
 - (2) That officers include details of attendance in each report to Annual Council to inform Members when appointments to outside bodies are reconfirmed.
- 6.2 The information supplied by Councillors who responded to Democratic Support is included in **Appendix 2**

7.0 Conclusion

7.1 Council is asked to consider its appointments to outside bodies, partnerships and boards as set out in this report.
