Prevention of crime and disorder:

The sale of alcohol from 07.00 to 00.00 7 days a week will encourage increased alcohol consumption in the town center, even though it may be in alleys. Consumption of alcohol in the town center is prohibited.

Prevention of public nuisance :

The sale of alcohol from the hours of 07.00 to 00.00 7 days a week will encourage antisocial behaviour

As alcohol consumption is prohibited in the town center, and this is predominantly a commercial not residential area, it will increase use of alleys surrounding the area to consume alcohol.

It will also increase public nuisance

in the form of increased littering in the alleys next to the shop. There is already an issue with rubbish including bottles, drinks cans and food containers in Back Sun Street and around the steps at the rear of the China Street car park.

There has also previously been a fire of paper/shredded paper on the steps at the rear of the China Street car park.

There has been an incident of a commercial glass bin being tipped over, again in the area of the steps,
- seemingly to find alcohol in bottles in there.

There has been an incident of human faeces in the alley behind the Sun Hotel.

The steps outside The Cornerhouse on the corner of New Street and Church Street opposite the applicant premises appear to be regularly used by homeless people. Selling alcohol from 07.00 to 00.00 would encourage

Additional comments:

The application is for Luna Bargain yet the shop is called Lune Bargain.

There is already provision of alcohol sales off premises in the area at the shop on the corner of Church Street and Cheapside, Tesco Express King Street and Sainsburys on Cable Street.
