SRB16 Shared Service Budget 2025/26 - (Revenues & Benefits) (Paragraph 3)

The Director of Resources (Preston City Council) submitted a report on the Shared Service Agreement between Lancaster City Council and Preston City Council, which required that the Joint Committee approve the annual revenue, capital and staff budgets in respect of the Revenues and Benefits functions.

The Joint Committee would then inform the two Councils of the amounts of their proposed contributions to the Joint Committee's budget.

As part of the debate Members commented that they would like to see the following considered at a future meeting:

Internal auditors. Look to rotate the use of auditors in order to make budget savings.

Automation of processes. Look to put in place as soon as possible. Report to July's meeting in order to save money/not to reduce jobs. City Council representatives supported the use of the Pathway System in order to target recovery.

For Lancaster CC Quarterly Monitoring reporting. To include improvements such as the improvement of collection.

Increase of 2.63% of tax base. To provide information to demonstrate the amount of student housing returning to residential.

To consider future meetings being held in Preston in view of the majority of attendees travelling from Preston and that ongoing actions raised at the meeting be added to the preamble of the minutes.
